OUR TIME IN THE WORD

Now that we are in Christ, now that we are alive in Him, we are responsible and expected to live a certain behaviour, you and I must live differently.
We are expected, commanded to live a life reflecting Christ.

To have Christ Centered life, we have to let...

1) The Peace of Christ – Rule (v15)

- Allow the divine Peace, the ruling Peace to be the umpire of your life, submit to it's authority, offer it to the body of Christ

2) The Word of Christ – Dwell (v16)

- Allow the Bible to inhabit, to take residence in you, to change you

3) The Name of Christ – Be Glorified (v17)

- In everything you do, glorify Christ. There is no separation between the spiritual and the secular. The lordship and glory of Christ must penetrate and be reflected in every aspect of our lives.

REFLECTIONS

How confident can we say that we are living a Christ centered life?

1. When we make decisions, do we submit to the authority of the Peace of Christ? Do we recognize it in the first place and do we obey it?

2. Do we allow the Bible, the Word of Christ to penetrate us and change us? Are we committed to seek after its counsel?

3. Are we mindful that everything about us is a representation of who Jesus Christ is? Do our lives reflect that we are under His Lordship? Do our lives bring honor and glory to His name?
